**LIVERY CO-WORK EXHIBITS ART OF STANLEY MOUSE, "THE MAN WHO DREW THE FACE ON ROCK MUSIC"
Opening Reception on November 18 Benefits Sebastopol Center for the Arts**

SEBASTOPOL, Calif., October 26, 2022— As part of its mission to enliven and enrich public life in Sebastopol, support local arts, and create inspiring places for the community to gather, work, and play, Farm to Coast Collective is pleased to announce a benefit reception to launch its exhibit of the art of Stanley Mouse at The Livery CoWork. Reception guests will meet “The Man Who Drew the Face on Rock Music,” view works from the artist’s own collection, enjoy light bites from cult pop-up Second Staff, and sip wines and beers from local producers. Proceeds from admission will benefit The Sebastopol Center for The Arts. Selected works by the artist will be available for purchase.

Artist Stanley Mouse’s large body of work runs the gamut from hot-rod and monster art to lush oil paintings, but he is perhaps best-known for his 60’s era album covers and concert posters including the iconic skeleton-and-roses Grateful Dead motif. The Livery CoWork is honored to present a showing of Stanley’s work, both “Wild” and “Fine.” The public may view the exhibit Monday through Friday from 10am to 4pm through the end of the year.

Stanley’s posters have been exhibited across the globe including The Louvre, SFMOMA, Tokyo Museum of Modern Art, The Victoria and Albert Museum in London, and The Rock & Roll Hall of Fame. His art is in private and public collections including The Hermitage and The Oakland Museum and his cover art for Steve Miller’s album Book of Dreams won a Grammy Award in 1977.

The Livery CoWork, a 3,100 square-foot coworking hub located on two levels, is the latest venture from Sebastopol-based The Beale Group (TBG) family of businesses. It is the first phase of The Livery on Main campus in Downtown Sebastopol that will be home to a carefully curated collection of local micro-restaurant licensees, a small indoor/outdoor event venue, and rooftop garden slated to open in late 2023.
